



# Baloo Training

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) Training is a one-day training event that introduces parents and leaders to the skills needed to plan and conduct pack outdoor activities, particularly pack camping. Come to camp for a day full of fun, food, and interaction with other Cub Scout leaders.

This training is required for any adult who is in charge of planning a pack campout, and it is recommended that one adult per pack complete BALOO training. You must list a BALOO-trained leader on Tour Permit applications to conduct pack and Webelos den campouts.

When: Saturday, August 15, 2009. Registration begins at 7:30am, course ends at 5:00pm.

Where: Camp Old Indian

Cost: \$15.00 -- includes materials, breakfast, lunch, and fun.

Bring: Pencil or pen, leader books, your favorite mug or cup, and an enthusiastic attitude.

Please be prepared for hot and/or rainy weather.
