Join us at Camp Old Indian for this year's Cub Resident Camp. All displays, games and crafts will reflect the tropics and the theme- Paradise Island.

WEBELOS SCOUTS : *Four days and three nights of adventure at Camp Old Indian!! Don't forget to bring you're your tent for the overnight on Thursday! night!* Webelos and parents will tent camp Thursday night at Camp White Pines and will enjoy a dinner cooked over an open fire and have a campfire program .

CUB SCOUTS : *Enjoy three days and two nights of adventure at camp Old Indian!!*

THE ADVENTURE BEGINS

Take a refreshing dip in the lake-maybe do some fishing while you are there. Learn to shoot an arrow straight and true or hit your mark with BBs. Try your hand at crafts, cooking, and other activities while having fun and working on Cub Scout or Webelos Scout achievements. The week will end with a campfire Friday night and camp-wide games and recognition program on Saturday morning.

CHECK-IN: Webelos- 4th and 5th graders this fall check-in is on August 5th, from 4-6 p.m. Eat before you arrive or bring something with you. The first meal served at camp is breakfast.

Cub Scouts- 2nd and 3rd graders this fall check-in is on August 6th, 4-6 pm. Eat before you arrive or bring something with you. The first meal served at camp is breakfast.

HUNGRY? Our meals will be served in the Dining Hall and special diets can be accommodated with at least two weeks notice.

TIRED?-OUR ADIRONDACK SHELTERS PROVIDE A GREAT REST

All Scouts and their adult partners will sleep on bunks in Adirondacks (three-sided shelters). Webelos Scouts and their adult partners will tent-camp at Camp White Pines on Thursday night only.

TRADING POST: Bring a few dollars if you'd like to buy T-shirts, snacks, crafts, or souvenirs.

OUTFITTING YOUR TRIP TO CAMP OLD INDIAN

SCOUT UNIFORM: Shirts, shorts, belt, socks, cap

CLOTHING: Shoes, socks, shirts, shorts, long pants, lightweight jacket, poncho or rainwear, swim suit and underwear. (No open-toe shoes)

SLEEPING BAG: Sleeping bag or sheets, pillow, blanket.

TOILETRIES: Soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, comb or brush, deodorant, towels, washcloth, insect repellent, sunscreen.

MISCELLANEOUS: Flashlight, extra batteries, pad/pencil, money for the Trading Post, camera, personal first-aid kit, Scout Handbook.

WEBELOS SCOUTS: Should bring: tent, extra blanket, sleeping pad, ground cloth, canteen or water bottle, watch, compass, sunglasses, matches or firestarter (no lighters), and pocket knife (remember, you must have earned your Whittlin'Chit and have it with you in order to carry your pocket knife. We'll be checking!)

Please do not bring: Radio, CD player, TV's, Gameboy, Gamegear, hand axes, personal BB guns, or bow and arrows.

Note to Adults: Use of tobacco products is not permitted at camp .

HOW TO REGISTER

Parents should complete all portions of the individual Registration Form and send with fee to the Blue Ridge Council Service Center, 1 Park Plaza, Greenville, SC 29607. Please make a copy of the registration form for your son's unit leader.

It is required that a ratio of one (1) registered adult be maintained for every registered Cub Scout or one (1) registered adult for every three (3) Webelos Scouts. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** If no adult partner registers, boys will be placed on a standby list.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Camp will provide a secondary accident insurance policy. All claims will be filed first on the Scout's parent/guardian's insurance, then on the camp's insurance.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

There will be a certified Health Officer on staff. A fully equipped health lodge stands ready. A local physician is on call along with the hospital. Each participant-youth and adult-must have completed a Health Form to submit at check-in. The Health Form will be mailed with your confirmation letter.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY:

When a parent/guardian is not at camp, staff will attempt to contact the parent/guardian before taking the youth to the doctor or emergency room. The camp phone number is 864-895-8989-**Emergencies only, please!**
